No specialized poster session is planned.

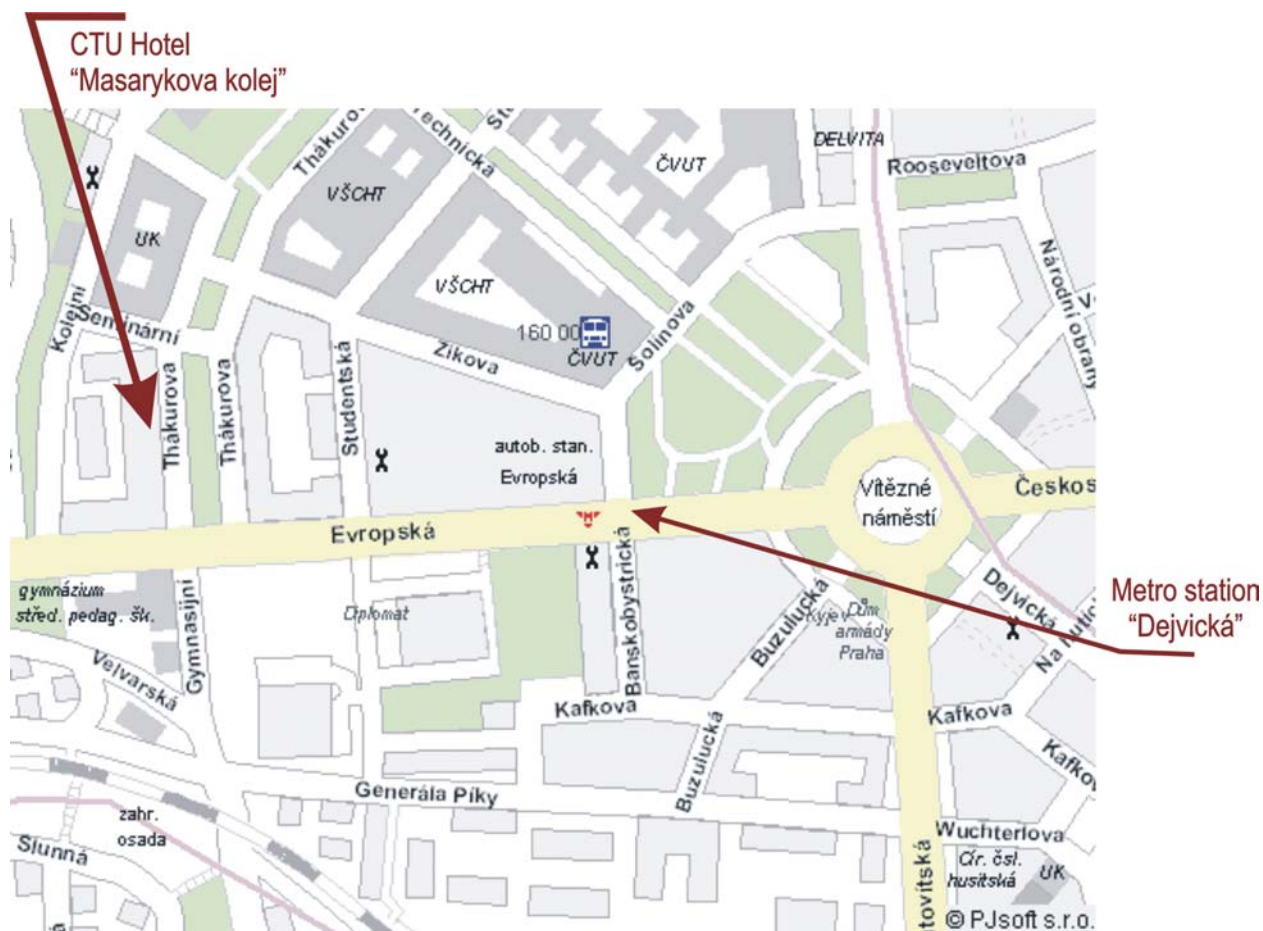
Fees

Transport from the airport

Municipal transport – Bus no. 119 goes directly to Metro Station Dejvicka (terminal stop).

Fare – 12 CZK (details in section transport).

Airport minibuses – CEDAZ – 90 CZK

Taxi cabs – Airport cabs – FIX cars – 400 CZK

AAA taxi – order only by phone 14014 – 250 CZK

Transport from the railway station “Hlavní nádraží”

Municipal transport – take Metro (line C) in direction “Háje” to station “Muzeum”, where change to line “A” direction “Dejvická” and go to terminal station.

Taxi cabs – not recommended

Transport from the railway station “Nádraží Holešovice”

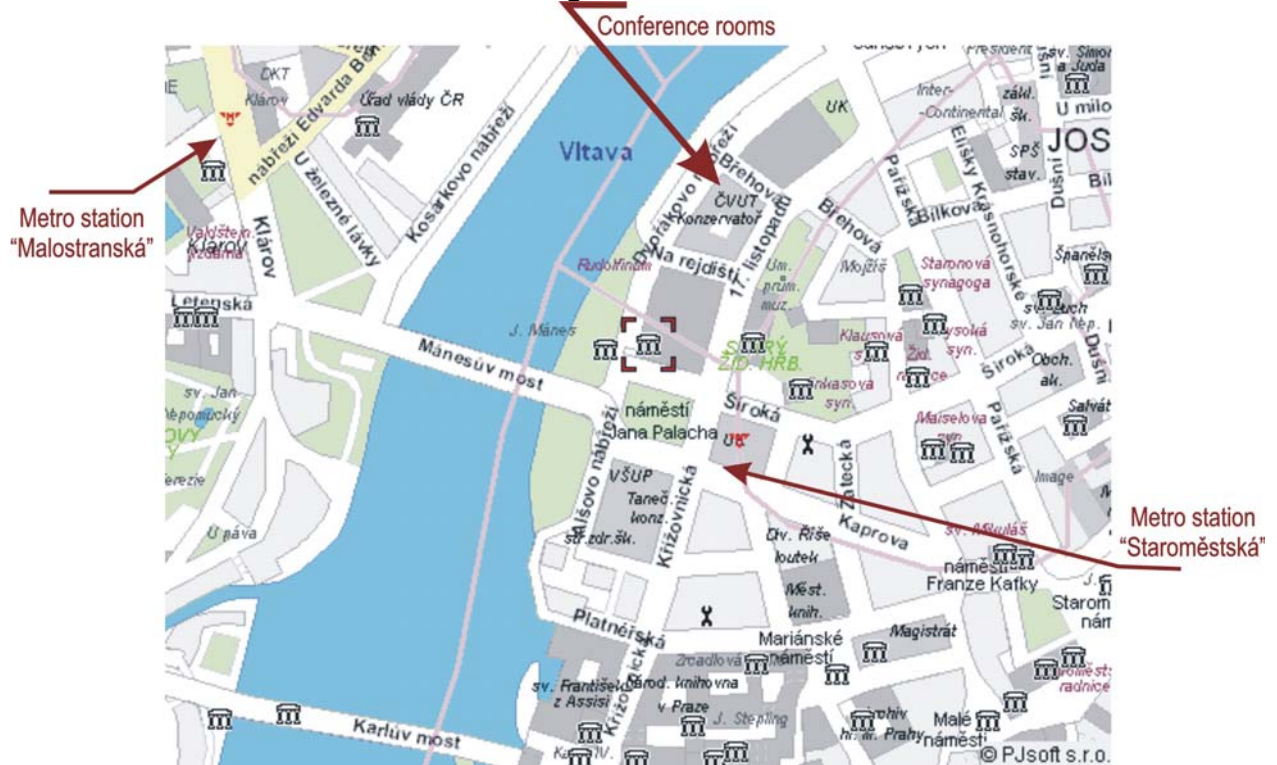

Conference site

Building of “Faculty of Nuclear Sciences and Physical Engineering” of CTU, Břehová 7, Praha 1, in walking distance (200 m) from Metro station “Staroměstská”.

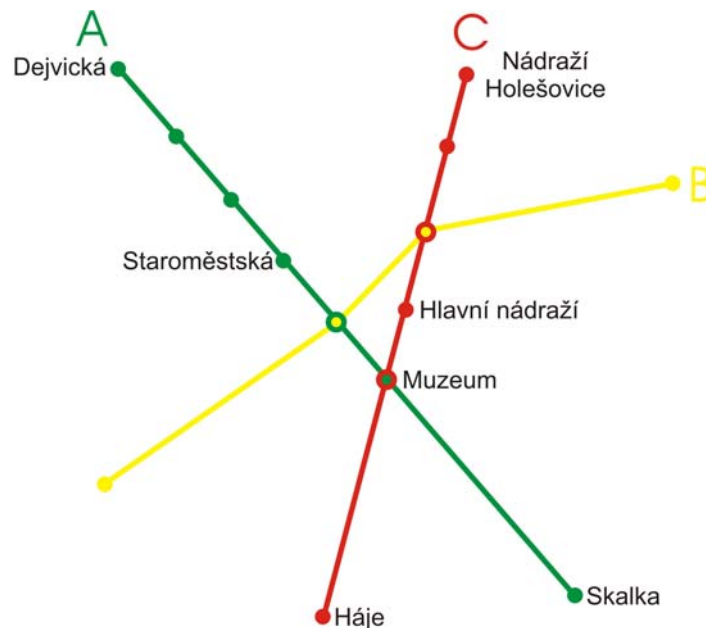
A scheme of the conference site surroundings



Transport from the CTU hotel “Masarykova kolej”

Take metro from the station “Dejvicka” to station “Staroměstská” (direct connection – 3 stops)

Prague transport

Prague Municipal Transport – network of Metro (operated from 5 a.m. to 12 p.m.), trams, buses, night trams and night buses.

Tariffs – 12 CZK – transfer – valid 60 minutes for all types of transport inside city limits
8 CZK – non-transfer short-distance – 4 stops in Metro 15 minutes bus or tram
200 CZK – 3 days (72 hours) for all transport within city limits
250 CZK – 7 days (168 hours) for all transport within city limits

The tickets are sold by ticket machines (at all metro station or at the airport), at tobacconist shops and stands, at Prague Municipal Transport desk at the airport etc.

At first use the ticket must be inserted into a printing machine at Metro entrance or inside tram or bus immediately after boarding.

Taxi cabs – Prague taxi drivers are world ill-famed for extensive over-pricing, the best way is to avoid it is to ask hotel reception for ordering taxi for you or to order it by phone (AAA taxi – phone number - 14014 - mostly recommend, dispatcher speaks English and taxi arrives fast). If you stop moving taxi or if you take hauling taxi (not recommended) try to gain information about approximate price. The maximum prices inside city borders (with exception of Prague Airport) is 22 CZK/per km + 4 CZK/1 minute + 30 CZK boarding. Please, contact hotel reception before paying excessive price.

Safety precautions

Pick-pockets operate in crowded tourist places and municipal transport.

Russian speaking participants are advised not to answer questions in Russian from unknown people as specialized criminality does exist in Prague.
